- Growing Regions Grants Program: Provides grants of between \$500,000 and \$15 million to local government entities and not-for-profit organizations, for capital works projects that deliver community and economic infrastructure projects across regional and rural Australia. The program will invest in critical regional infrastructure and community projects across regional and rural Australia through two \$300 million funding rounds. Round 1 of the program is open for stage 1, applicants have until 5pm on 01 August to submit an expression of interest.
